Weavers: Sett is 18-20

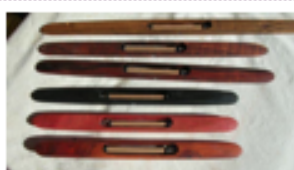
On the loom.....
