Knitters: 26 sts and 32 rows = 4" on US #4

Weavers: 10-12 epi

Each skein is 350 yards/100 gm

This <u>book</u> is written for those working on rigid heddle looms, but is certainly full of great ideas and projects for any weaver. It includes several finger controlled weaves; pick up methods (yarn - not people!), several rug or wall hanging weaves and lots of other warp and weft faced fabrics. For those wanting to use 2 heddles on the rigid heddle loom - there's a whole chapter

devoted to this process. The book contains explanations, drafts, pictures and projects it's a great resource!
