I'm finding myself extremely overcome with spring fever.... and it's earlier than usual around here! Hope you're not letting spring fever keep you from your fibery passions.

2 NEW WILD SILKS

Just in - 2 new silks from Treenway,

Muga (wild) Spun Silk 30/2 -

Nice honey color with aprox 1450 yards per 100 gm skein.
Weavers: Sett @ 30 epi
Knitters: Lace Weight



Tussah Peduncle Wild Silk 20/2 -

This is a very unusual silk made from the stem part of the cocoon. Nice medium brown - best used as weft only and suitable for pouches, table runners, placemats. It's a bit on the rough side, so definitely not suitable as a wearable.

Aprox 900 yds per 100 gm skein



ASANA BULKY

Here's another alpaca yarn for you - now I have a bulky weight! This one is 50% Superfine Alpaca + 50% Peruvian Highland Wool (Made in Peru). It's a thick and thin yarn - great texture. Currently 5 colors. 200gm skein = 280 yds.

Knitters: Size #10 @ 3.5 st/in

Weavers: think Weft!



NEEDLE BOWLS



For placing pins and needles in while working on projects. Can also be used to contain earrings, rings, etc. Variety of exotic hardwoods. 3/4" - 1" by 3" round
