SUSTAINABLE COTTON

These yarns are made from cotton that is grown in colors other than white. The color is a part of the fiber and therefore does not need dye. The cotton is grown in the southwestern US, and spun here in the US. It is produced by a consortium of growers that are using sustainable farming practices such

as Integrated Pest Management, sensible water usage and low chemical input.

These yarns are called American Maid cottons and listed under Organic and Sustainable Cottons. They are available in natural colors of light and dark green or brown. Sizes:
