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SEAM RIPPER



We all use them! - Why not have one that is beautiful and easier to use, since it has a thicker handle (made from **exotic woods**) than any other one I've ever used.

The "ripper" part stores inside the handle when not in use - and is inserted into the handle when you are using it.

And if you've ever been really frustrated with all the unevenness when winding 2 yarns - you might want to consider getting one of these shuttles or putting it on your wishlist.
